2 Kings 5:9-16, 22, 25-27

Notes:

1. Naaman is commander of the army of the king of Aram—a very respected man
2. Leprosy was one of the most feared diseases. Those with leprosy were taken away and made to live in a leper colony.

Questions:

1. Can you remember a time when your pride was injured? What did you do?
2. Naaman had to swallow his pride and dip in the Jordan River to get well. Which dip do you think was most difficult for him? Why?
3. Naaman was healed after the 7th dip. What do you need to be healed from? What do you need to wash out of your life?
4. Gehazi, Elisha's servant, idolized material possessions. Do you do the same? What's more important? Fashioning your wardrobe, or your relationship with God?
